What we're looking for

Some core tasks for this role will be:

- To deliver a high standard of service to all patients at MMH referred to the team, working autonomously.
- Use clinical judgement to select appropriate assessment tools, methods, techniques and equipment from a wide knowledge base in line with individual patient needs and wishes and refer patients onward if necessary, liaising with other agencies if required.
- To undertake a clinical caseload to a high professional standard, using specialist knowledge and skills from theoretical and practical experience.
- To assess patients' understanding of assessment and gain valid informed consent and work within a legal framework with all clients, including those who lack the capacity to consent to treatment.

Some of the skills required for this role are:

- Minimum of 6 years post registration experience which demonstrates the competencies to meet the role requirements outlined in the JD
- Experience working in different areas of Occupational Therapy including orthopaedics, musculoskeletal, neurology, respiratory, rehabilitation
